

Applying for a stall at Sharrow Vale market

- 1. Print out the application form and complete it to supply the information required. All sections of the form must be filled in. Incomplete forms cannot be processed.
- Post the completed form, together with a cheque for the relevant fee to Sharrow Vale market

- 4. All cheques should be payable to Sharrow Vale Community Association (SVCA)
- 5. **All stalls** must provide evidence of public liability insurance cover including the expiry date. Details of the insurance must be submitted with your application. If you have any problems with insurance please ring 0114 2680003 for advice.
- 6. **All stalls** need evidence of a risk assessment. There is a risk assessment form available to download from the website.
- 7. **All food stalls** must provide both evidence of the risk assessment (see 6 above) and a separate fire risk assessment. (Form available to download from website)
- 8. All food stalls must provide your food hygiene rating (if applicable)
- 9. Please read the supplementary information in the Frequently Asked Questions section before sending in your application form. This should answer most of your queries and ensure that you know what is expected from you and what you can expect from us.

*This is an 'Application Form' and <u>not</u> a guarantee that you have reserved a space.
We aim to contact you a month before the market date to let you know if you have been
successful or not; you will receive an email either way. Please make sure we are on your safe
senders list. You will be told the pitch number in that email, please note which 'zone' it is in
from the first page of this document.
If your application has been unsuccessful your cheque will be shredded <i>after</i> the market applied
for, just in case you are chosen for a cancellation. If you would like it returned to you please send
a stamped addressed envelope with your application or after the market date.
Sharrow Vale Rd is a one-way road for most of the area used for the market. This is not officially
closed until 9.30am an reopens at 5 p.m.We do not like stalls to be cleared before 4pm, even if
you have run out of produce, please take the opportunity to market yourself/your products.
All road space will have been allocated for stalls, so vehicles must be parked off site. There is
stallholder parking at Kingfield Synagogue - 127 Psalter Lane, S11 8UX; this is a way
away so you will need to have thoroughly unpacked your vehicle. There is no space to
have your vehicle parked near or next to your stall once unpacked.
You will be allocated a $3m \times 3m$ space. If you have a requirement for more please specify this
on your application form; increased charges may apply depending on the size required.
Only space is provided: there are no tables or gazebos for you to use, you must bring your own
stall set (inc. weights) and make sure it is weatherproof! \odot
There is <u>no</u> electricity provided.
There is a WC for stallholders located at the rear of the Pet Shop.
Stallholders handling food are required by law to have undertaken Food Hygiene training and
operate in accordance with current UK legislation.
All stallholders using bottled gas or any other inflammable substance need to have appropriate
safety equipment including fire extinguisher (powder for gas), fire blanket and heat resistant
gloves and provide us with a Fire Risk Assessment before the market.
All stallholders are required to have their own Public Liability to be shown on the application
form
In the event of our cancellation of the market your payment will be returned in full or held over
for the next market by your instruction.
In the event that you wish to cancel after being approved: your deposit will <u>only</u> be refunded if
we are successful in filling your allocated space. If you wish to cancel within 2 weeks of the
event you may not be eligible for a refund although we will do our best to find a replacement.
No matter how late, if you can't attend please do let us know, it is likely there will be others
who would jump at the chance to have a pitch.

This is a community run market; please <u>do not leave trade waste</u> on site or you may not be invited to attend again as you may have unwittingly found that you have contributed to the SVCA being charged with flytipping.
